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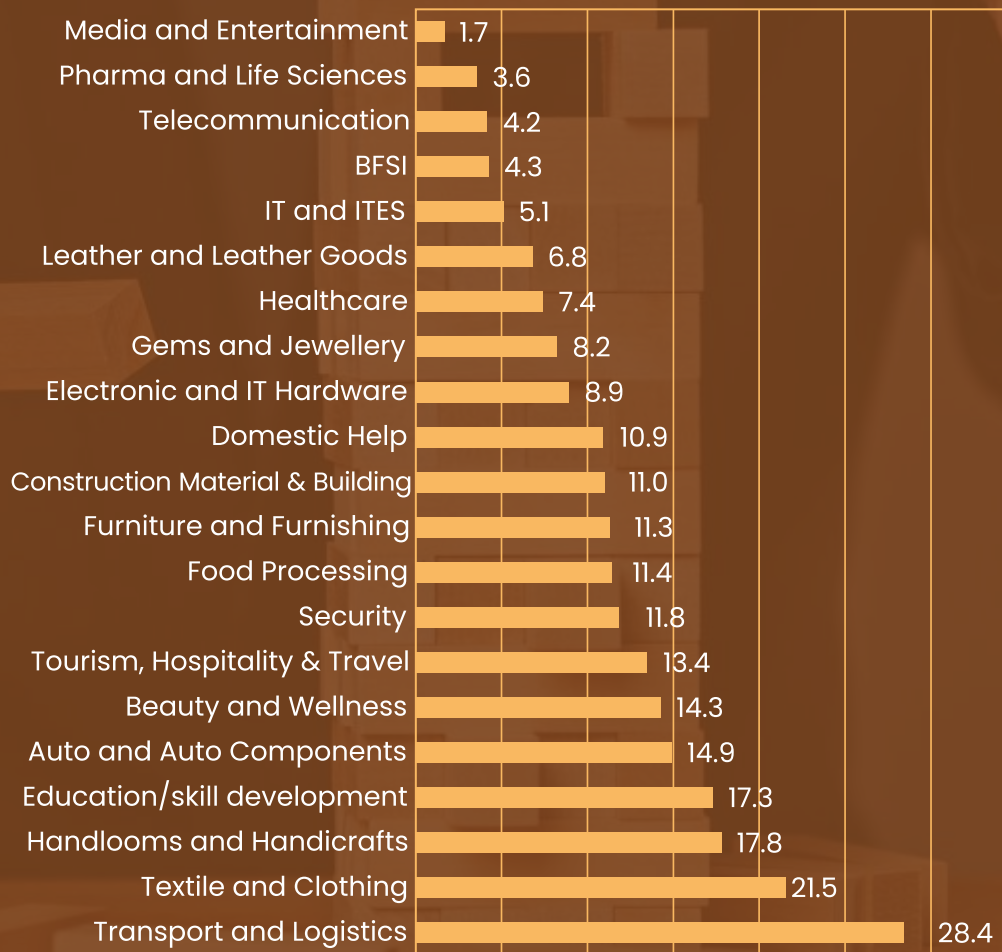

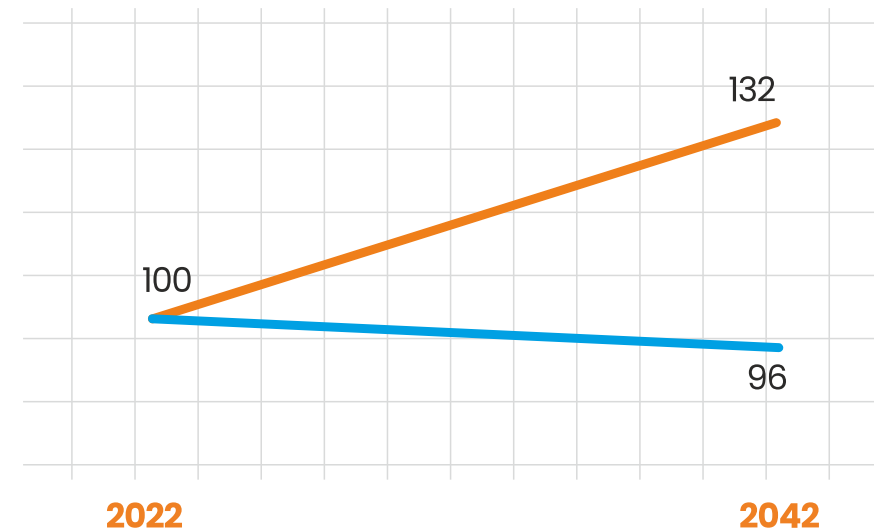
India Scenario

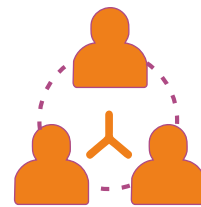

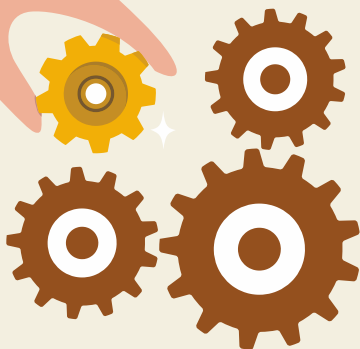
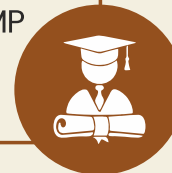
State has upgraded 10 Divisional ITIs to Global standards by providing state of the art facilities.



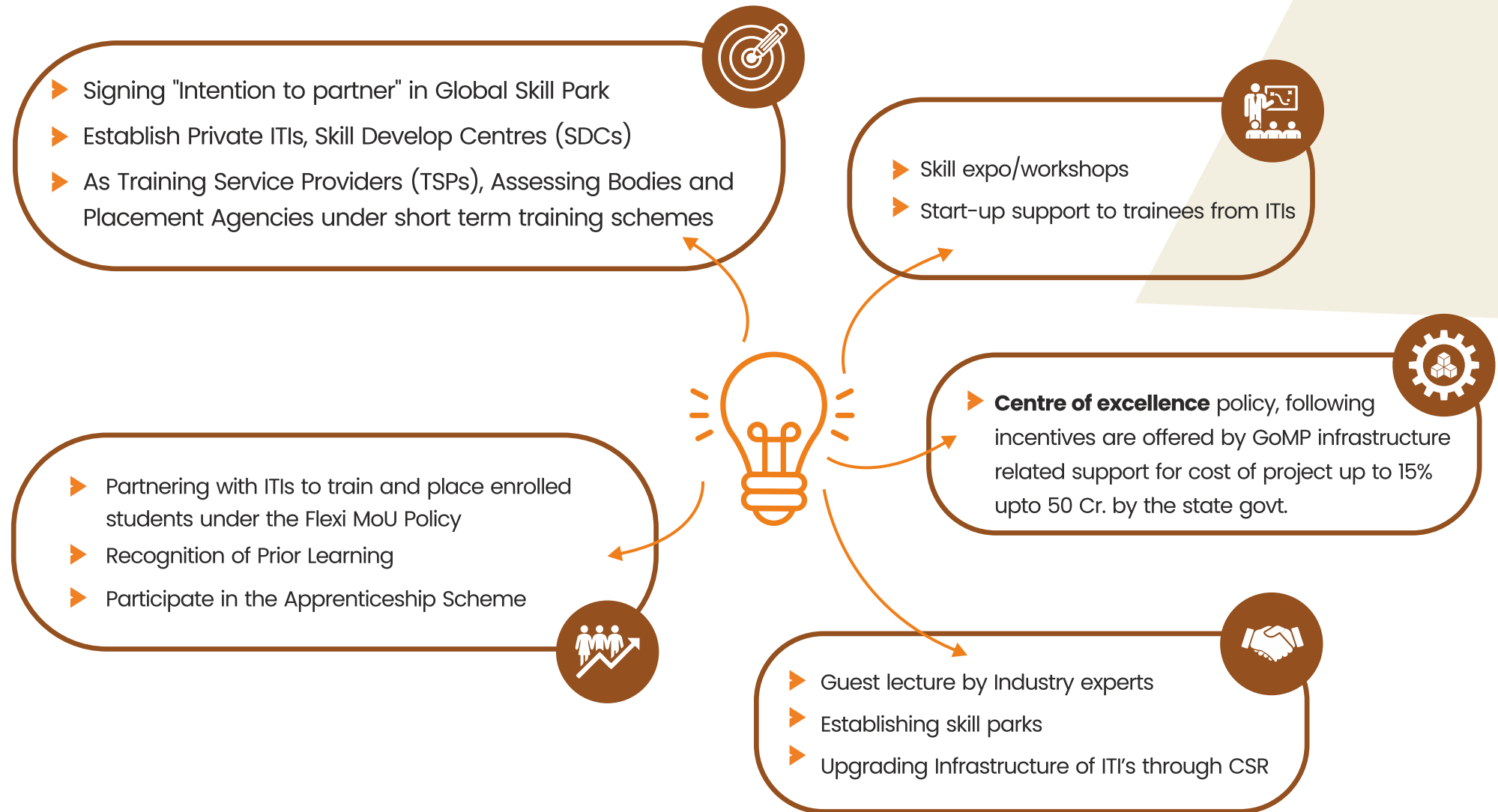
