

- Thirteen Cities and Towns on the stem of the main rivers with a population above 75,000 and less than 1 lakh



- Indore ranked as Cleanest City for sixth consecutive year and India's first 7-star Garbage Free City.
- Bhopal ranked in 5 Star Garbage Free Certification.
- ► In SS2022, Total 324 ULBs have been certified as ODF++ and 6 ODF+ 38 ODF and 2 ULBs i.e. Indore and Bhopal Water+.
- India's largest Bio-CNG plant that will run on the principle of waste to wealth, can produce 17,000 tones of biogas in a day from 550 tones of organic household waste.

MP METRO RAIL CORPORATION LTD

- Two corridors of Bhopal, with total length of 27.87 km and estimated cost of INR 6941.40 Cr have been approved.
- The ring line for Indore, with total length of 31.55 km and estimated cost of INR 7500.80 Cr has been approved.



PRADHAN MANTRI AWAS YOJANA- HOUSING FOR ALL

- 9 Lakh is the estimated housing demand.
- ➤ A total of 9,26,959 (BLC-7,25,590, AHP-59,323 & CLSS-1,42,046) housing units at a cost of 45,000 Crore have been approved for these projects.
- ▶ Under the Mission, 8% of the total sanctioned houses in the country are sanctioned in Madhya Pradesh.

Smart City Budget provisions

- MoHUA has planned to release the INR 1000 Cr funding to all Smart Cities by June 2023 based on their fund utilization
- ▶ National Urban Digital Mission Scheme planned to be launched in the top performing States with a vision to strengthen ICCC's and e-governance services.
- > 183 projects are under implementation stage worth 2918 Cr.



MADHYA PRADESH HOUSING & INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT BOARD

- ➤ Out of the 342 acres ABD area, 111 acres (42 Plots) of saleable land with estimated base price 1590 Cr. is estimated for ABD projects
- > 654 Cr. Tendered (11 Plots) , 428 Cr. Awarded (6 Plots)
- 190 Cr. Realized ,238 Cr. Yet to be Realized
- > 177 Cr Under Tendering (4Plots)

INDORE SMART CITY ABD LAND MONETIZATION

- ➤ Tendering Process for 03 Blocks (1.34 acres) out of 11 Blocks of MOG lines Parcel (nearly 19 acres) is in progress with an offset price of Rs. 80.71 Cr
- Tender for remaining 08 Blocks is planned in next month.



Public Assets Management System

Prepare policy guidelines/directives on rational use of public assets and ensure compliance by concerned departments.

Create and maintain State Assets Register using IT and GIS.

➤ Rationalization of state assets and ensure optimum utilization through inter-departmental consultation and coordination.

Disinvestment of State PSUs

Generate revenue for the state through monetization of unused assets.

Provide advisory services to other departments on PPP projects.

Develop in-house capacity to explore, identify, design and execute asset monetization opportunities.

Impacts

57 assets have been monetized resulting in revenue receipts of Rs 414 Cr. against the awarded amount of Rs. 670 Cr. so far.

Rs. 46 Cr has been received (FY 2021-22) under the scheme for special assistance to states for capital investments.

Reassignment of 62 assets from one department to other departments for urban local bodies use, industrial area, green spaces park, bus stand and wayside development.

CMINFRASTRUCTURE

- Infrastructure development in cities
- Phase-I: 1428 Cr, Phase -II: 1800Cr. & Phase III: 536 Cr, Additional 400 Cr for Road Improvement Program and Phase-IV Proposed for 1700 Cr, Total 4164 Cr.
- bodies, costing Rs. 443.25 crore has been approved.

EXTERNALLY AIDED (WATER & SEWERAGE) PROJECT

- Madhya Pradesh Urban Development Company Limited (MPUDC) is the implementing agency for externally aided projects in urban water sector like ADB, KfW, World Bank.
- ➤ World Bank Assisted MPUDP Project cost is about USD 153 million.

 Work is being done on sewerage projects in 7 Urban Local Body

 (ULB) and water supply projects in 3 urban local bodies.
- Asian Development Bank assisted Madhya Pradesh Urban Services Upgradation Project (MPUSIP) at a project cost of USD 669 million executed in Phase-I and AF.
- ➤ Kreditanstalt für Wiederaufbau (KFW) bank is assisting Madhya Pradesh Urban Sanitation and Environment Program (MPUSEP) – Project Cost Euro 75 million.



INTRASTATE, INTERCITY, INTRACITY TRANSPORT SYSTEM

- ▶ 20 Transport Special Purpose Vehicles (SPVs) formulated under AMRUT Scheme.
- Amount of Rs. 258 Cr. allocated for operation of Intra & Intercity buses in 20 SPVs.
- ➤ At present 1395 (414 Intercity & 981- Intra city) buses are under operation in 15 transport SPVs.
- ➤ Additional 950 buses (867-Intra city & 83-Intercity) are proposed to be procured for both Intra-city & Intercity routes by urban Local bodies of the state.
- ▶ Dedicated Urban Transport Fund (DUTF) for cities formulated to make transport SPVs self sustaining.

INITIATIVE OF DEVELOPMENT REGULATION & INCETIVES (T&CP AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY)

- TOD policy has been implemented in the state and TDR rules have been made effective in M.P.
- Transferable Development Rights Rules, 2018, there is a provision to give transferable development rights to the holder (land owner) through Development Rights Certificate (DRC).
- ➤ The administration is also working on creating zones to allow TDR holders to use or charge money, as decided by government, to transfer right to build more floor area than base floor area ratio (FAR) to developers.
- TDR benefits have been proposed for property owners of roads proposed to be developed under Indore development scheme (master plan) 2021. It includes the roads, MR3, MR5, MR9 and Mr11

MADHYA PRADESH HOUSING & INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT BOARD

Under the MP Re-densification Policy, MPHIDB is currently handling USD 300 million worth of projects.

ADB assisted 10 Mega ITI worth USD 40 Mn

Housing Projects (Ongoing & Proposed) - USD 200 Mn.

ENERGY SAVING INITIATIVES FOR ALL URBAN LOCAL BODIES (ULBs)

- There are approx. 10 Lakh street lights in Madhya Pradesh.
- 4.5 Lakh Conventional street lights has been replaced with energy efficient street lights
- ➤ Retrofitting/Replacement of remaining 5.5 Lakh fittings to be done by ULB's on EPC/PPP mode




E-VEHICLE POLICY AND INITIATIVES

- Under Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of Electric and Hybrid Vehicles (FAME- I) Scheme, 40 electric buses are under operation in Indore.
- ▶ 80 Electric Buses are proposed to be operated in Indore city under AMRUT Scheme.
- Under FAME-II scheme, 217 electric chargers will be established in Bhopal, Indore and Jabalpur cities.

RE-DENSIFICATION POLICY OF GOVT OF MP (MP HOUSING DEVELEOPMENT BOARD)

- ➤ GoMP Re-densification Policy has paved way for construction of New, Modern and Essential Government facilities/ Infrastructures in a planned manner at various locations of State by engaging Developers through PPP mode.
- Re-densification Projects acting as a win-win business model both for the Govt. of Madhya Pradesh as well as the Developers.
- > 5 Re-densification Projects worth \$17m completed, 24 Projects worth \$138.36m are under construction and 20 Projects worth \$145.18m have been approved.
- Average bid values received so far: 37% higher than the reserve price of the CLPs including a maximum bid of 150% above reserve price
- Under the MP Re-densification Policy, MP Housing & Infrastructure Board is currently handling USD 300 million worth of projects. ADB assisted 10 Mega ITI worth USD 40 Mn. Housing Projects (Ongoing & Proposed) USD 200 Mn.
