







Top 3 Countries, number of start-ups distribution










Incentives for Start-ups in Madhya Pradesh

MP Start-up Policy and Implementation Scheme 2022

For all type of start-ups

Start-ups can get assistance @ 15% (maximum of ₹ 15 lakh) per investment by SEBI registered AIF or RBI registered bank / NBFC. Available up to 4 times during the life span of the start-up

Additional 20% assistance to women-led start-ups

Lease rental reimbursement of 50%, max. up to ₹ 5000 per month, for 3 years

Max. assistance of ₹5 lakh for patent



End-to-End online application for financial assistance



Incentives for Start-ups in Madhya Pradesh

Additional incentives for product based start-ups

Skill development and training reimbursement for max. 25 employees @ ₹ 13,000/year for 3 years

Facility availability in MSME technology center

Electricity duty exemption and tariff @ ₹ 5/unit for new connections for 3 years

Government procurement support

₹ 5000 assistance per month as employment generation assistance, for max. 25 employees till 3 years

Madhya Pradesh is among the Top 10 Indian States for the number of MSMEs


MSME Contributes 30% to India's GDP and 40% to total exports

The State has 4% of the total MSMEs in India


